Dear Chief Peaks,

The Los Feliz Improvement Association (LFIA) strongly supports efforts to replace Fire Station 35, currently located at 1601 N. Hillhurst Avenue.

Station 35 is one of the oldest stations currently in operation. Its facilities are outdated and in desperate need of repair. It has come to our attention that the current owner of a property just south of Station 35 (a car dealership at 4531 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles 90027), will be going out of business. They will thus be vacating the premises and offering the property for sale. This gives the Fire Department a unique and timely opportunity.

The LFIA strongly supports building a new and expanded station at the car dealership location to replace the current Station 35. By replacing the old Station with a modern facility, the Fire Department would have the resources it requires to properly protect the community, and improve the lives and safety of the residents and businesses of Los Feliz, Silverlake, and East Hollywood.
