Thank you for attending our forum last night and for presenting such valuable information about crime in Los Feliz. On behalf of the Los Feliz Improvement Association and the entire Los Feliz community, I want to express our gratitude for the constructive and effective policing we enjoy from you and the entire Northeast Division.

You asked me to send you specific pockets where alleged criminal activity has been reported to me by residents. They are:

- Finley Avenue between Edgemont and Mariposa, and in particular Kenmore.
- Ambrose Avenue cul-de-sac near Normandie.
- The entrance to Laughlin Park on Normandie.
- The stairs on Cromwell Avenue at Berendo Avenue, and the stairs on North Catalina Avenue.
- Prospect Avenue in general.
- Marshall High School and neighboring streets after 4 p.m.
- The Bryn Mawr cul-de-sac.
- Oxford and Serrano Avenues near Los Feliz Blvd.
- The Rowena Reservoir area up to Waverly.

The complaints I have received mainly concern young men hanging out, loitering, drinking liquor, or using drugs. The residents are very intimidated by this behavior which mainly occurs after 10 p.m.
